ELA's 4 Objectives



Easier **access to information** and labour mobility services for individuals, employers and social partners



Strengthened **cooperation between national authorities** in cross-border enforcement, including inspections



Mediation in disputes between Member States on the application of EU law concerning labour mobility

Supporting cooperation between Member States in **tackling undeclared work**

Scope of the Authority **for all sectors** Labour mobility and social security coordination

- **Free movement of workers and EURES** (Regulation EU No 492/2011; Directive 2014/54/EU, Regulation (EU) 2016/589);
- **Posting of workers** (Directive 96/71/EC (as amended by Directive (EU) 2018/957) and Directive 2014/67/EU);
- **Social security coordination** (Regulations (EC) No 883/2004 and 987/2009);
- **Social aspects of international road transport rules** (Regulation (EC) No 561/2006; Directive 2006/22/EC; Regulation (EC) No 1071/2009).

Priorities: Inspections

- 5 meetings in 2020
- ELA co-organisation of **#EU4FairWork** campaign with Platform UDW. Finished on 16 November, it reached 16 million people across the EU
- The WG developed **tools and procedures** for ELA concerted and joint inspections. These deliverables include comprehensive Guidelines, workflows, templates and a mapping of the applicable legislation across the EU.
- **Pilot inspections** in September 2020, in the context of the #EU4FairWork campaign and the **EUROPOL** - EMPACT Joint Action Days
- **Training** programme started on 26 November, targeting national inspectors, with a train the trainer model
