TRANSUNION: THE BEGINNING OF GENDER TRAINING




- Concern about gender equality in transport

 - Collective bargaining for women





EVE: PROJECT EXTENDED, BENEFITS EXTENDED



- 4 months extension due to cost-effectiveness, positive feedback, demand for training ->
 1 additional language for M4 and the TK, and 2 additional trainings
- Translated Module 4 +Training kit in Spanish
- "2 more trainings in July 2018 \rightarrow reps from ALL sectors; interpretation in languages not supported before: Romanian, German, Serbo-Croatian and Turkish
- Covered Balkan region, Baltic region, Germany, Austria
- Very interesting project ideas and input from participants in the 2 additional trainings
- Seminars boosted general networking and partnership between unions in SEE (South-Eastern Europe), not only on gender equality
- Lessons learned" booklet sharing the organizational capacity improved, the challenges overcome, and the knowledge acquired during the project


