



## **Hungary eases Covid19 measures**

The number of vaccinated people has reached **5,8** million in Hungary (meaning 60% of the population), thus the following measures are in place from **7th September 2021**.

## GENERAL:

No restrictions for opening hours for shops, and no restrictions on the number of people entering the shops.

# HOTELS, RESTAURANTS, BARS, LEISURE FACILITIES (SWIMMING POOLS, SPAS, MUSEUMS, ATTRACTIONS ETC...):

are open to everyone (including foreign travellers as well), no immunity ID is required

## **†††** RESTRICTIONS FOR BUSINESS EVENTS:

#### Outdoors:

- up to 500 pax, no restrictions
- over 500 pax, only people with proven immunity against Covid19

#### Indoors:

- only people with proven immunity against Covid19
- in the case of foreign participants, an immunity certificate recognised by Hungary or an EU digital Covid certificate proving vaccination or recovery is acceptable.
- $\,-\,$  The immunity certificate cannot be replaced by a negative PCR test to enter events.

#### MASKS:

Face masks are NOT mandatory anymore, only in hospitals and health and social institutions

### **★ TRAVELLING TO HUNGARY:**

- Free entrance for all travellers arriving by road, rail and waterway
  from Croatia, Austria, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia and
  Ukraine, regardless of nationality or immunity against Covid19, is
  possible without restrictions, but providing other general
  conditions of entry (e.g. valid travel document) is necessary
- Free entrance for all travellers arriving by air with EU Digital COV-ID Certificate
- Free entrance for travellers with immunity/vaccination ID arriving from the following non-EU countries: Albania, Bahrein, Republic of North Macedonia, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Morocco, Moldova, Mongolia, Montenegro, San Marino, Serbia, Turkey, Ukraine, Uzbekistan
- Business travellers can enter without any restrictions, only a registration form needs to be filled.
